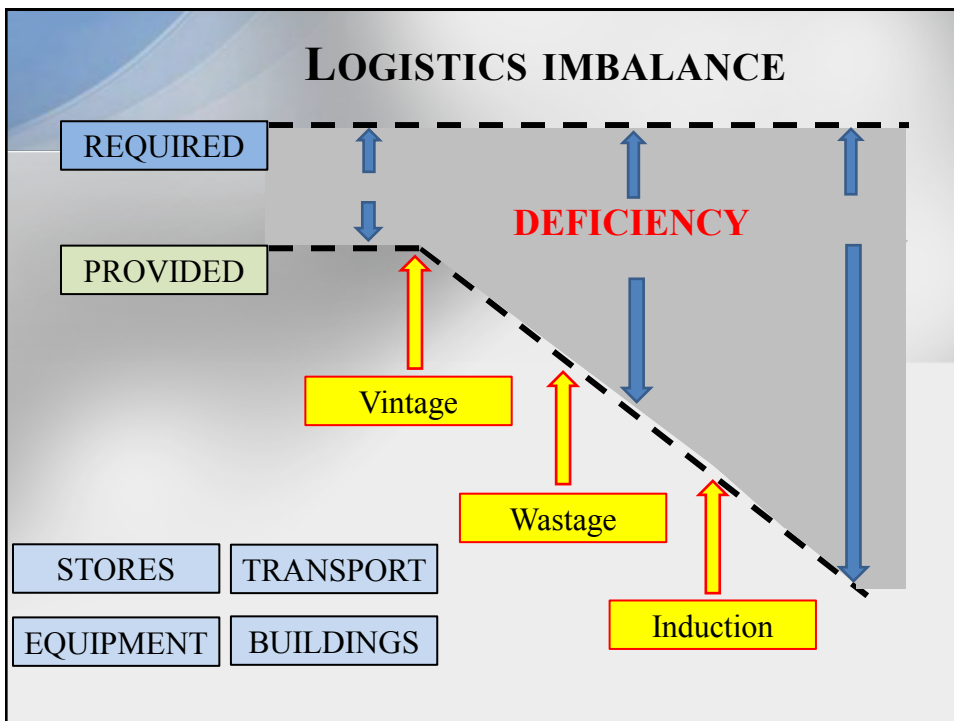

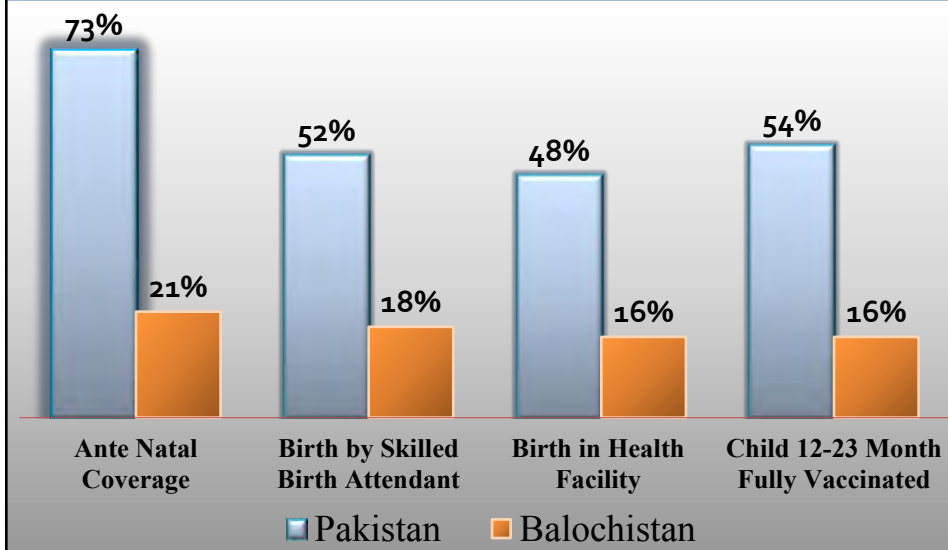

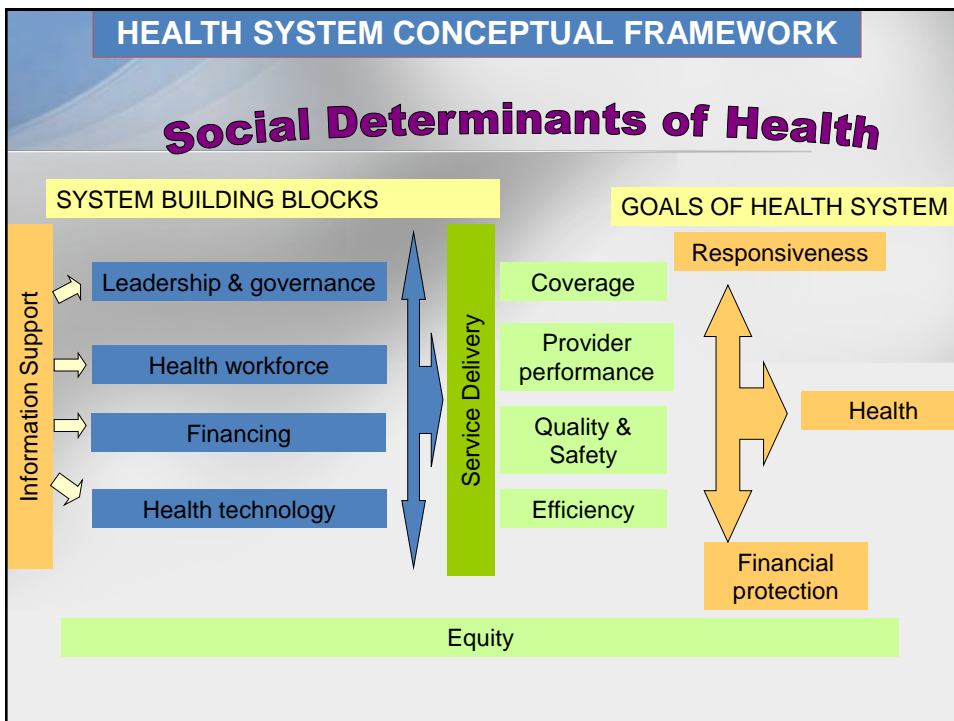
## TOP 5 DISEASES COMMUNICABLE & NON-COMMUNICABLE

Communicable Disease	Non-Communicable Disease
1. Acute (Upper) Respiratory Infections	1. Fever due to other causes
2. Suspected Malaria	2. Urinary Tract Infections
3. Diarrhoea/Dysentery in >5 yrs	3. Hypertension
4. Diarrhoea/Dysentery in <5 yrs	4. Dental Caries
5. Scabies	5. Peptic Ulcer Diseases

## .....DESTINATION 1

**Development of a vibrant and active Health Policy and Health Sector Strategy:**

- **A Health Policy is now on draft stage**
- **A Health Sector Strategy with assistance of TRF has also reached final shape and is under active consideration for final approval.**

## .....DESTINATION 1

➤ **The Health Sector Strategy is designed to address:**

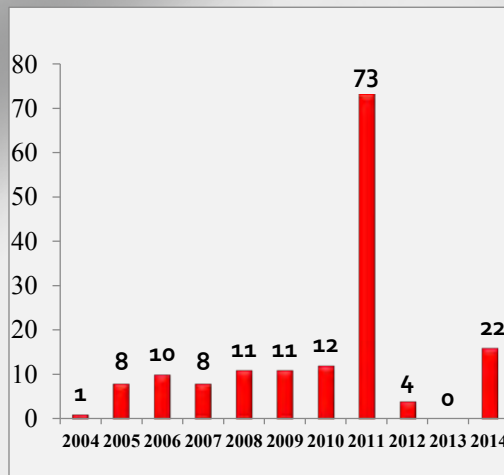
- 1) **To improve governance and accountability through system approach**
- 2) **To harness the private sector through regulation and capacity building for a joint effort towards achieving the MDGs and beyond**
- 3) **To rationalise health workforce with appropriate staff mix and skill mix**
- 4) **To expand and strengthen lifeline preventive programmes including non communicable diseases.**
- 5) **To rationalise allocation and utilisation of resources by improving financial management and mitigating risk**

## .....DESTINATION 2

- **Strengthening the District Health Management System particularly DHMTs**
- **Introduction of Performance Based Monitoring and Assessment at the District Health System which is reviewed at the Secretary office on quarterly basis.**  
*(UNICEF and WHO have pledged for technical support)*

## .....Destination 3 (A POLIO FREE BALOCHISTAN)

- ✓ **Interrupt transmission of polio virus by 2015.**
- ✓ **Eradicate the virus by 2018 as Polio End game strategic plan.**
- ✓ **Strengthen EPI in the Province**
- ✓ **Legislation on vaccination**



## .....DESTINATION 4

- **Alternative Financing and Poverty Reduction initiatives, particularly introduction of Health Insurance to address inequities in short to medium term.**
- **Development of a Public private partnership scheme to strengthen the private sector in the province.**

## .....DESTINATION 5

- **To develop a continuing medical education program for all medical, nursing and paramedical staff linked to career development.**
- ❖ ***Establishment of 03 new medical colleges***
- **Legislation to streamline the retention of human resource specially Medical Practitioners at the district level**

## .....DESTINATION 6

- ❖ Reviving the HSRU for oversight, M&E and active coordination (*With the support of WHO*)
- ❖ First Inter Provincial Conference on Health Governance to be held in the month of February,2015 (*with the active support of UNDP*)

## .....DESTINATION 7

- **Strengthening of Hospital Based services system in 16 districts on an innovative “Health Facility Point” design which will provide facility based, referral and outreach services for the focused district and also the adjacent district**
